Steve's office at Temple City Blvd and Live Oak offers a full array of services including Tax Preparation, Insurance and Investments, Legal and Real Estate.

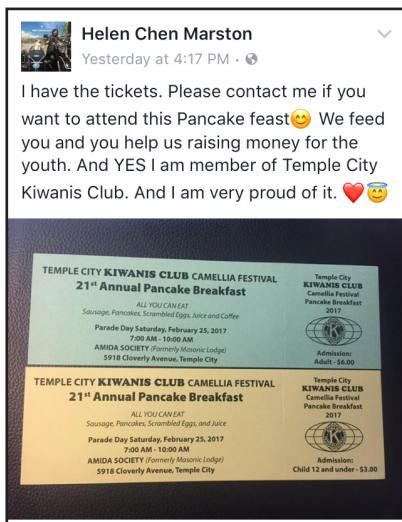
