Temple Station is responsible for law enforcement services for the contact cities of Bradbury, Duarte, South El Monte, Temple City, Rosemead, and much of the surrounding unincorporated area. Captain Jacob is very familiar with Temple City having served here off and on as Sergeant and Lieutenant before coming back as Captain. She replaced Captain Chris Nee who is now working at headquarters.

Also on hand was Sergeant Ron Miranda who is also a 25-year veteran. In my opinion we are very fortunate to be a "contract city". We receive all the resources of the department in case of a major emergency without all the headaches and problems associated with our own law enforcement. Just ask Sierra Madre.

We have dedicated deputies such as Capt. Jacob, Sgt. Miranda, Deputies Lam, Zuninga, and Adams that are committed to providing a superior level of service with an emphasis on "quality of life" for Temple City residents. One of the reasons we are a safe city is they make sure that thieves get the message that they can not do their business in Temple City. Programs such as monthly Neighborhood Watch meetings educate citizens about crime trends and tips promoting public safety.

If you ever want to educate yourself you are welcome to attend the monthly law enforcement meetings at City Hall Community Room. They are on the last Wednesday of each month from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m.. This is a public meeting and a free breakfast is provided by the city through our own Dave Seltman.

Temple Station will celebrate its 90th anniversary this September. It is the 5th oldest station in the county. A big celebration and open house is planned later this year.

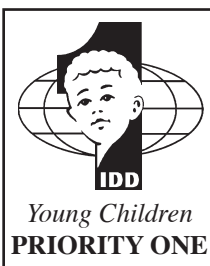
