Our speaker for the day was Raina Martinez with Foothill Unity Center. She has been with them for 10 years as the Development and Donor Relations Director.

We have designated Foothill Unity as the recipient of food collected from the Postal Food Drive on May 14. We are still working out the logistics of transporting more than 18,000 pounds of food to them.

Celebrating their 35th Birthday, Foothill Unity Center is a place of real hope and possibilities for those impacted by poverty. Helping over 10,000 individuals almost every year, Foothill Unity Center is the primary provider of food, case management/crisis help, and health care resources across eleven San Gabriel Valley cities in LA County. With help centers in Monrovia and Pasadena, Foothill Unity Center serves people with dignity and also provides those who wish to help with opportunities to make a difference.

Founded in 1980 in a church closet to provide food to a few hungry families, the Center has become the major source of food, health services and crisis assistance for at least 4,000 low-income families in our Southern California service area: Pasadena, Altadena, South Pasadena, Arcadia, Sierra Madre, Monrovia, Duarte, Azusa, Baldwin Park and Irwindale. In 1991, the Center was incorporated. In 2008 it was federally designated the Community Action Agency for the Foothill Area of Los Angeles County.

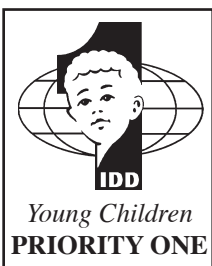
