The mission of the Pasadena Ronald McDonald House is to provide a community supported "Home Away From Home" for families coming to the Pasadena area seeking advanced medical treatment for their critically or terminally ill children.

Since they opened in 2004 more than 13,000 children and families have stayed at the two classic 1912 craftsman style homes directly across from Huntington Memorial Hospital.

They receive 10-15% of their \$650,000 annual budget from McDonalds franchises and the balance from fundraising. They have 3 full-time staff members: Director, Special Events, and Operations. Pictured to the right are just some of our Angels of Mercy along with Elizabeth (in red).

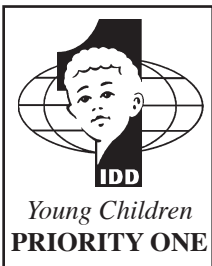
