Jim Waterhouse spoke to us about the Citizens Climate Lobby. Jim is an Arroyo High School English teacher, He is a fifth generation Pasadenan. His Great Grampa was Pasadena Mayor in 1905. He lives on Longden in the house his grandpa built in 1925.

He took an interest in climate science in the 1980's when Dr. James Hansen presented his findings to Congress. In 2011 Jim co-founded the Pasadena Foothills Chapter of the Citizens Climate Lobby, a non-partisan, all volunteer organization seeking to create the political will for a livable planet.

Based on what climate scientists and economists tell us, they believe that Carbon Fee and Dividend is the best first step to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and to mitigate the impacts of a changing climate.

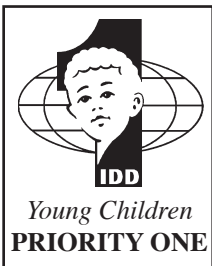
