Matt Smith's niece is hiking the Pacific Crest Trail. I don't think I can hike 2,659 feet let alone 2,659 miles. They began their hike at the bottom of California going north through Oregon, Washington, British Columbia Canada. The lowest point is 140 feet at Cascade Locks and the highest at Forester Pass at 13,153 feet. They began in April and hope to complete their hike ending up in Canada in October. They hike about 20 miles a day.

There has been a resurgence of The Pacific Crest Trail because of the movie The Wild. It sounds like a lot of fun if you don't mind the blisters, not being able to take a shower, bug bites, lighting strikes, snow, heat of the desert, and buying supplies up to \$8,000. Makes me appreciate the Hilton all the more.

The Pacific Crest Trail is 2,659 miles long and ranges in elevation from just above sea level at the Oregon-Washington border to 13,153 feet at Forester Pass in the Sierra Nevada. The route passes through 25 national forests and 7 national parks. Its midpoint is near Chester, California (near Mt. Lassen), where the Sierra and Cascade mountain ranges meet.

It was designated a National Scenic Trail in 1968, although it was not officially completed until 1993. The PCT was conceived by Clinton Churchill Clarke in 1932. It received official status under the National Trails System Act of 1968.

Matt and Janet Smith were fortunate to meet up with their niece when she made it to Wrightwood. We hope to have her give us a first-hand glimpse of her hike someday.

Guest for the day was Matt's father-in-law Jack Barrie. Steve Montesanti is happy that he finished his round of radiation. Steve celebrated by eating a hamburger as he awaits a good test result in about a month. I only have to wait 20 years to catch up with them.

Congratulations to Dan and June Snell celebrating 72 years of marriage on June 22nd. Wow, I was three months old when they tied the knot.

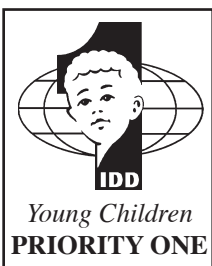
