## LAST TUESDAY

Find The Children was our program for the day with presenters Rora Jones; Executive Director, Natily Gonzalez; Case Manager, and Sandra Habre; Community Outreach.

Is it possible to steal your own child? Yes, and it's against the law. Have you ever been afraid that your child or grandchild will be kidnapped by a stranger? Do you know that it's much more common for a child to be taken by a parent or another family member. Some people think that you can't steal something that is already yours, but when it comes to children, that's not true. Children are not like a piece of property. It hurts them when they are uprooted and kept from other people who they care about.

It's a crime for a parent, relative, or any other person to take away, hide, or keep a child from the other parent or person who has rights to the child. Some people think they can avoid California laws by taking their child to another state or country, but the District Attorney's Office will send investigators anywhere to bring them back; just the way they do in other crimes.

The Find The Children was founded by Linda Otto in the 1980's. All this was brought into prominence with the abduction of Adam Walsh. They are located in Santa Monica and serve all of Los Angeles County. Find The Children is a non-profit organization dedicated to the recovery of missing children and the prevention of child abduction. All their programs and services are free of charge, with funding coming from grants and private donations.

Their three main objective's our **Education** through Preschool, Kid Intuition, Teen Intuition, and Parent Presentations. **Prevention** by reaching out to the community through its school and parent educations programs by providing safety tips. **Recovery** through the Reunification Program, designed to reduce the trauma of abduction for children and their families and to support a successful and lasting reunification.

Code Adam is a "missing child" safety program in the United States and Canada, originally created by Wal-Mart retail stores in 1994. It is named in memory of Adam Walsh, the 6-year-old son of John Walsh (the host of Fox's America's Most Wanted). Adam was abducted from a Sears department store in Florida in 1981. His body was never recovered. Today, many department stores, retail shops, shopping malls, supermarkets, amusement parks, hospitals and museums participate in the Code Adam program. Legislation enacted by Congress in 2003 now mandates that all federal office buildings employ the program. It is a known fact that if the abducted child is a girl an abductor can grab some boy's clothes off a rack, cut their hair in an attempt to leave with your child unrecognized.

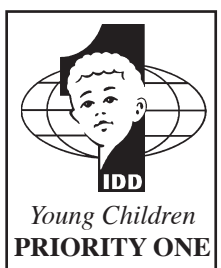
