LAST TUESDAY

Our speaker for the day was Carol Daughterty. Carol is President of the Historical Society and Secretary of the Woman's Club. She spoke on the history of the oldest church in Temple City. Temple City United Methodist Church has a history that dates back to over 100 years having celebrated the 100th Anniversary in 2010. It is also home to Boy Scout Troop 161 that is celebrating 95 years of scouting.

The church's roots date back to 1908 when 30 people met for Sunday worship service at Santa Anita School, which is now the location of Longden Elementary School. The collection of worshipers formed an official church, known as the Mountain View Methodist Episcopal Church, in 1910 with the Rev. John Leonard Collins as minister. The church name would not stick, as it would change to Temple Community Church, Methodist Episcopal, in 1924, then Temple City First Methodist in 1962 and finally the First United Methodist Church in 1972.

Over the centennial, much of the church's well-documented history is highlighted with building renovations, pastoral staff changes and the come-and-go of other congregations sharing space with First United. The building of the infamous Noah's Ark-shaped sanctuary used today, and in 1990, the induction of its first female minister, the Rev. Mary Birgelaitis. The church witnessed Temple City's development from a town of chicken ranches and vegetable gardens to a bustling city many years before it became a city.
