Michael Forbes is Temple City's Community Development Director. He will speak to us about all the new things on the horizon and how he helps make it happen.

LAST TUESDAY

Our speaker for the day was Rick Miller. Rick is the President and Founder of CSI in Arcadia. He focuses on helping retirees and seniors protecting their nest egg from long term care, taxes, inflation, market risk and fees.

Rick's talk was entitled "The Elephant in the Room" with long-term care as the greatest threat. The new buzz words now are "Adult Day Care" and "Residential Care Homes". Long Term Care is very expensive and the averages stay is between 2-3 years. Rick explained a way of not paying further premiums and using the benefits up to that amount. Skilled Nursing care and cost upwards of \$7,500 a month for your loved ones.

With Long Term Care many seniors and their families mistakenly believe life savings are protected. The truth is Medicare and health insurance policies may pay for some short term skilled care, but it doesn't cover long-term care costs because this is considered custodial care.

Another big item that hardly anyone knew about was "Aid and Attendance" benefits. The Aid and Attendance benefit program is for veterans, spouses and surviving spouses age 65 and older. It provides financial reimbursement for nursing home care, home care expenses, assisted living facility expenses and board and care. There are certain requirements including dates of service but the benefits range from \$1,778 to \$2,675 a month. A little known secret with big benefits.

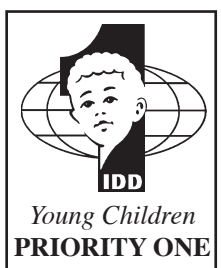
