The measure incorporates four amendments to the City Charter. 1) Eliminate gift and campaign contributions from developers 2) Limit eligibility for City Commissions 3) Establish definitive term limits for City Council members 4) Make some technical changes.

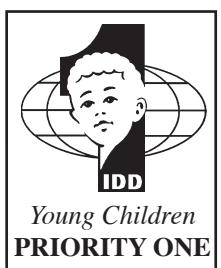
