LAST TUESDAY

Matt Smith gave us a look at the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals. Headquartered in San Francisco, California, the Ninth Circuit is by far the largest of the thirteen courts of appeals, with 29 active judgeships. The court's regular meeting places are Seattle at the William K. Nakamura Courthouse, Portland at the Pioneer Courthouse, San Francisco at the James R. Browning U.S. Court of Appeals Building, and Pasadena at the Richard H. Chambers U.S. Court of Appeals.

Panels of the court occasionally travel to hear cases in other locations within the circuit. Although the judges travel around the circuit, the court arranges its hearings so that cases from the northern region of the circuit are heard in Seattle or Portland, cases from southern California are heard in Pasadena, and cases from northern California, Nevada, Arizona, and Hawaii are heard in San Francisco. For lawyers who must come and present their cases to the court in person, this administrative grouping of cases helps to reduce the time and cost of travel.

There are 179 Circuit Court Judges throughout the United States who are appointed by Presidents of the United States. They are judges for life with a annual salary of \$214,000 per year. The 9th Circuit Court is based in Pasadena at a building that has various uses from a hotel, homeless shelter, to a war building hospital having been built in the 1890's. It was originally one story with another six stories added later with a bell tower.

The 9th is known as the most liberal of the Circuit Courts. According to the most current count, the Ninth Circuit has the highest percentage (68%) of sitting judges appointed by Democratic presidents. Republicans argue the court is biased because of its relatively high proportion of Democratic appointees. The Supreme Court has overturned more of their decisions than any other court.

One of the judges is Alex Kozinski who has served since 1985. Often he will give guided tours of the historic building and show classic family movies. He was sworn in by President Ronald Reagan.

Frank Ruedel was presented with his permanent badge and a get well card from the club. Matt Smith has set Wednesday, December 7 for Meals of Love for the Ronald McDonald House.
