With all of this she finds time to sit on Regional Boards such as the San Gabriel Valley Vector Control, LA County Library Commission, Council of Governments, and Foothill Transit Authority. Congratulations Cynthia for making sure that Temple City is well represented not only in Temple City, but the San Gabriel Valley.
